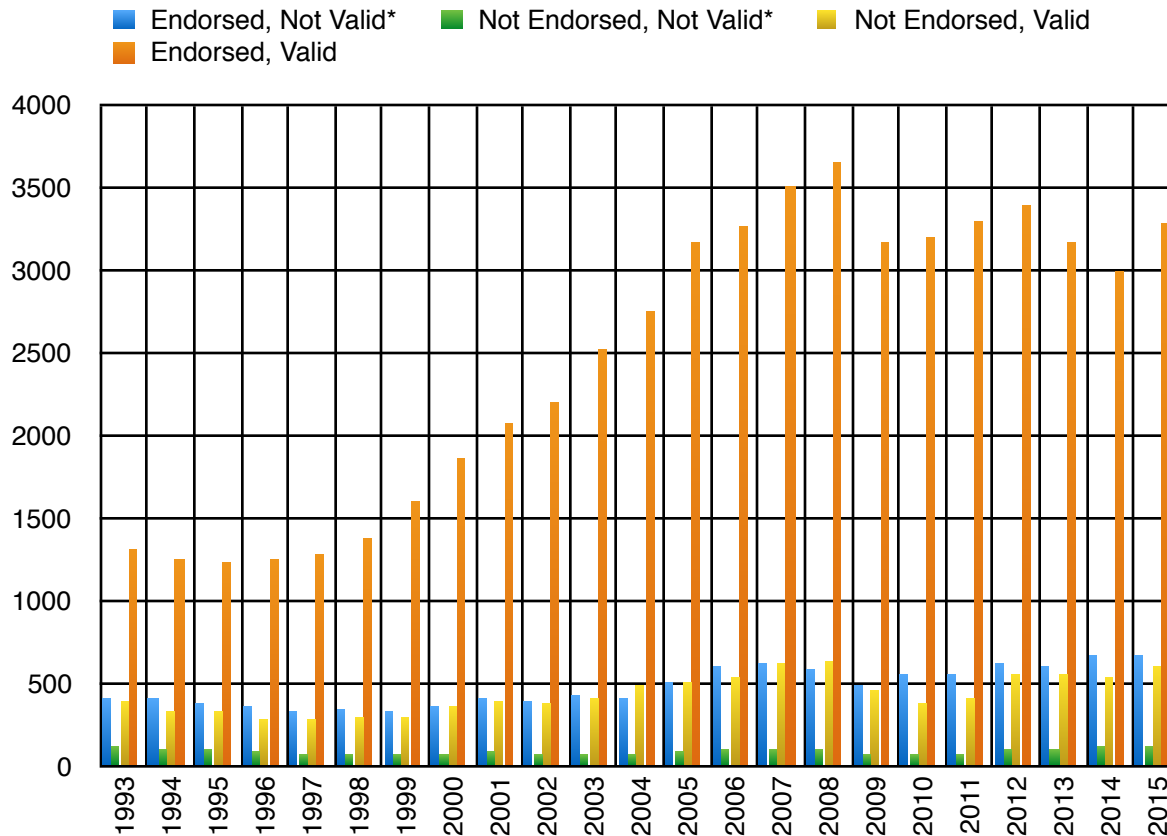


USA Motorcycle Drivers Fatally Injured Endorsed-But-Not-Valid-License Comparison

(Understanding the difference between Endorsed and Valid)



*Not Valid means: Suspended, Expired, Revoked, Foreign, Under 16

Many “Experienced and Endorsed” Motorcycle Drivers DO NOT have a “Valid” licensed at the time of the crash since their license was Suspended, Expired, Revoked, Foreign, or they were Under Age.

Experienced Riders have always dominated the fatality count. One needs motorcycle experience and practice to be able to ride one’s motorcycles fast enough and often enough to get killed.

Many experienced riders with suspended driver's licenses have and will continued to ride after suspension. They are still endorsed even though they do not have a "Valid" license at the time of the crash, since their driver's license was suspended.
